



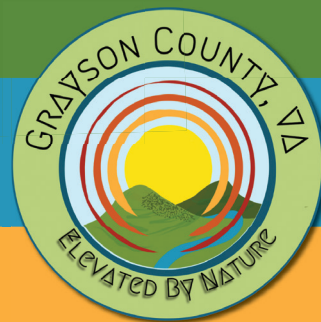

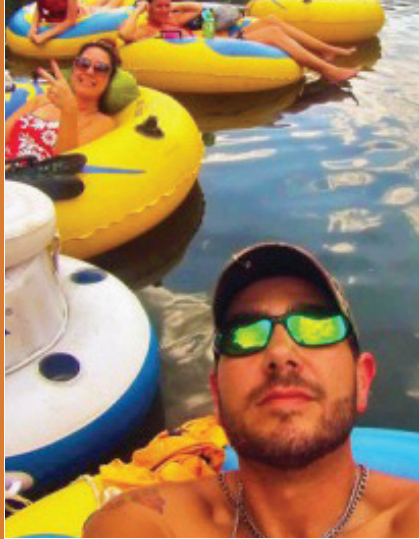

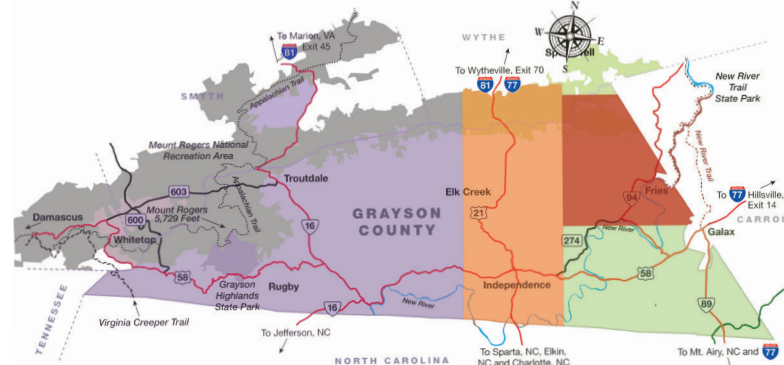

Connect with the natural areas of Grayson Highlands, the Blue Ridge Parkway & all the trails in between.

Hiking the Highlands

Day Hikes are available everywhere, from the western highlands of Grayson County to the eastern Blue Ridge Plateau.

Grayson Highlands State Park Everything from a challenging hike to Mt. Rogers (highest point in Virginia) to a casual stroll in the highland meadows.

Trails of the Jefferson National Forest are available along the western edge of Grayson County. Common trailheads include Comers Rock Recreation Area (Hwy 21) and the access points to the Mt. Rogers National Recreation Area at Highway 603 and Highway 600.

The Blue Ridge Music Center Trails take you to the top of Fisher Peak. The High Meadow Trail is 1.3 miles and the Fisher Peak Loop is 2.2 miles

Grayson County Recreation Park and the **Matthews State Forest** are hiking locations central to Grayson and near the county seat of Independence.

The Appalachian Trail, a 2,181-mile public footpath traversing the scenic, wooded, pastoral, wild, and culturally resonant lands of the Appalachian Mountains. Conceived in 1921, built by private citizens, completed in 1937, the trail is managed by the National Park Service, U.S. Forest Service, Appalachian Trail Conservancy, numerous state agencies and thousands of volunteers. Grayson County is proud to offer a delightful section of the Appalachian Trail. Trail access: Grayson Highlands State Park, Elk Garden trail head, Whitetop Mountain, and Rt. 603.



Trails for Children

Biking

Mountain Bikers. Enjoy the challenge of the Jefferson National Forest where countless single tracks are available. Single track trails can also be found at Matthews State Forest.

Grayson Gravel Traverse. A 72-mile gravel cycling route connecting the Virginia Creeper Trail to the New River Trail across Grayson County.

The New River Trail and the **Virginia Creeper Trail** are both rails to trails corridors. They provide wide surfaces and easy grades. Perfect for hiking or biking.

HORSEBACK RIDING/EQUESTRIAN

Horseback riding trails exist on both the eastern and western end of the county. In some areas horse camping is located near miles of horse trails. Check out the Parks and Recreation link to learn about the public areas available for horse riding. If you need supplies for your horses, many of the country stores in the area carry feed and tack for your convenience. Some offer horse camping, cabins and stables, horseback riding lessons, wagon rides or rental of horses for trail riding.

Public Areas and Trails

The Jefferson National Forest includes the Virginia Highlands Horse Trail, this trail offers 68 miles of wilderness which tranverses Grayson County from Elk Garden to Ivanhoe. For info: www.fs.usda.gov/activity/gwj/recreation/horseriding-camping.

Grayson Highlands State Park. Rugged mountain beauty and extensive trail system make it ideal for horseback riding. Everyone loves Grayson Highlands! www.dcr.virginia.gov/state_parks/grs.shtml.

The Virginia Creeper Trail near Whitetop, Virginia offers woodland riding next to a scenic trout stream. Great horsback riding trail and popular with bicyclists. Info: www.vacrepertrail.us/horses.html.



Horse Camping

Rocky Hollow Horse Camp located in Troutdale, Virginia on the western side of the county is a great location to bring your horses and escape with easy access to the trails of the highlands (JNF, Grayson Highlands) right from the campsite. They offer camping and cabins. www.ridem-trogers.com.

Hungry Horse East, also located in Ivanhoe, provides access to the Virginia Highlands Horse Trails and Jefferson National Forest. It is another great source for horseback riding, camping, cabins and other horse amenities. www.hungryhorseeast.com.

Virginia Highlands Horse Trail in the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area, is a 68-mile trail between Elk Garden and VA Rt. 94. It features mountainous terrain, valley views and valley crossings. The trail includes parking and primitive camping for those who trailer horses.

FISHING AND HUNTING

Grayson County is home to a wide variety of fish and game species. The **Department of Game and Inland Fisheries** offers the best information on fishing opportunities, regulations, and trophy fish.

Traveling to Grayson County for a hunting or fishing trip? Sometimes hunting or fishing rights can be arranged as part of a package for your stay, ask the proprietor if they offer

these services. If your stay includes hunting or fishing on public lands, please refer to the land use regulations for each agency.

In much of the western portion of the county, trout streams are stocked. Year round the New River offers a variety of fish species from wall-eye, bass and muskies. Our River outfitters are a good source for planning your fishing vacation. Hunting and Fishing supplies and licenses can be found at many of the country stores located across Grayson County. Stop in for supplies and who knows...maybe someone will tell you where their favorite fishing hole is!



THE CROOKED ROAD

The Crooked Road is Virginia's Heritage Music Trail, a driving route through the Appalachian Mountains from the Blue Ridge to the Coalfields region, following U.S. Route 58.

The trail connects major heritage music venues in the region such as the Blue Ridge Music Center, Birthplace of Country Music Alliance, and the Carter Family Fold.

The traditional gospel, bluegrass, and mountain music heard today was passed down from the generations and lives on through a wealth of musicians and instrument makers along the trail.

Annual festivals, weekly concerts, live radio shows, and informal jam sessions abound throughout the region. A variety of handcrafted woodwork, weaving, and pottery can be found in country stores and small workshops.

Numerous opportunities for outdoor activities, from hiking, biking, fishing and boating are also available along The Crooked Road.

THE SCENIC NEW RIVER

The New River is a great place to relax and unwind. This American Heritage River winds 30 miles through Grayson County. Enjoy a leisurely Class I float with the family or an adrenaline packed Class III shoal. Discover why everyone loves a day on the New River!

A day on the New River is the perfect way to relax and enjoy being on the water. The New River offers a variety of experiences: a tube float with the family, a canoe trip for the romantic picnic, or a kayak ride on a Class III rapid.

If you are unfamiliar with the area or need equipment a local outfitter can give you advice on the proper stretch of water, shuttle your boat and provide rental equipment.

Plan your float or fishing adventure using the New River Float Calculator. National

Geographic provides a detailed map of the New River as well.

Several vacation homes listed on our "Places to Stay" page are located on the New River. This is a great way to spend a weekend.

New River Conservancy

JEFFERSON NATIONAL FOREST

In 1995, The **George Washington National Forest** and **Jefferson National Forest** were administratively combined.

Together the two National Forests contain nearly 1.8 million acres of public land, representing one of the largest blocks of public land in the eastern United States. The Jefferson National Forest itself is comprised of lands located in Virginia, West Virginia, and Kentucky. 690,106 acres of the Jefferson National Forest are in Virginia, a large part of which is located in Grayson County, including the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area.

The Jefferson National Forest has 950 miles of hiking and riding trails, including 300 miles of the Appalachian National Scenic Trail

and the 68-mile Virginia Highlands Horse Trail, designed for horseback riders and wagon trains. The forest is mainly Appalachian mixed hardwoods interspersed with conifers. Wildflowers and autumn leaves create a profusion of color in spring and fall. Camping and picnicking are permitted forest-wide unless otherwise indicated. Check the website for the Jefferson National Forest for permitted uses and trail information.

Mount Rogers National Recreation

In the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area you will find: Mount Rogers, at 5,792 feet the highest mountain in Virginia; the Virginia Creeper Trail a former railroad now a popular biking, hiking, and

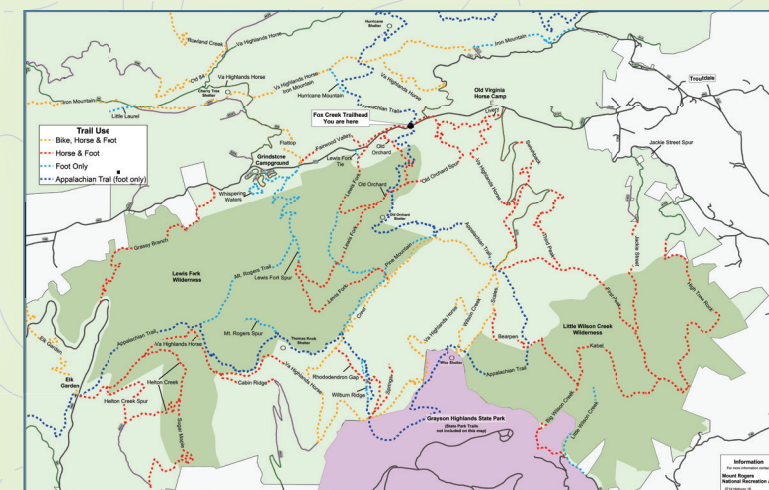
horse riding trail; miles of hiking, backpacking, and horse riding trails; the Appalachian Trail; numerous campgrounds; and three wilderness areas.

The Pat Jennings Visitor Center

Serves as the headquarters and gateway to the Mount Rogers National Recreation Area. Six miles from I-81, the Visitors' Center

provides maps of the Area. Pick up maps, nature guides, memorabilia, etc.

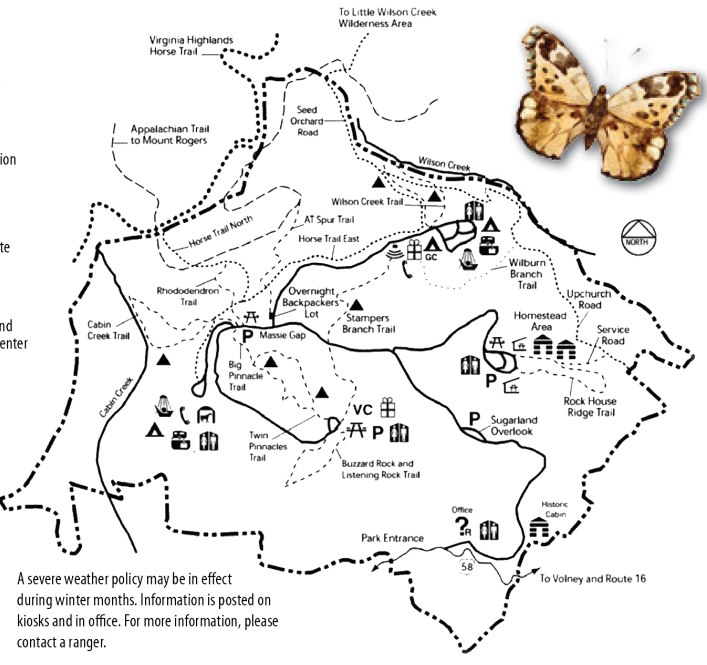

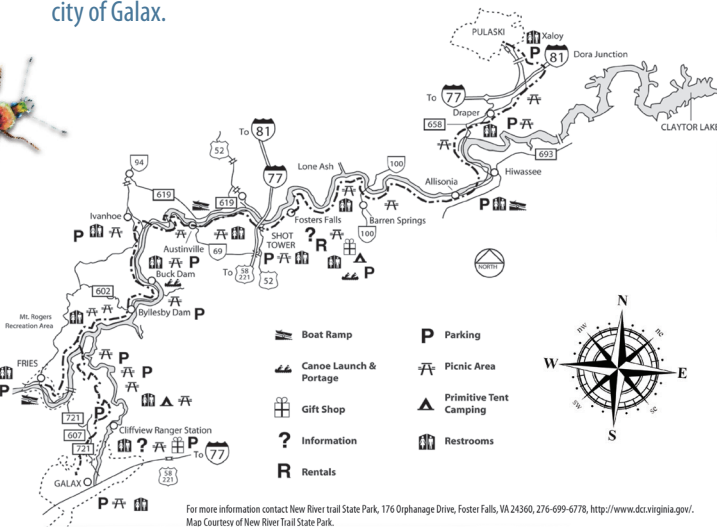
